Day	Practice reading and saying the sound. Do you know their letter names?	Practice reading some or all of these words. Try listening to all the sounds in the word and then blend them back together.	Try reading this nonsense word!	Activities.
Monday	s	sum sat sing	somp	Mr Teach listening game. What sounds can you hear? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=iuYnkMLJ-O4
Tuesday	a	at ask arm	api	Sing Humpty and see if you can hear the rhyming words.
Wednesday	t	tag tum tang	tast	Initial sounds: Make a collection of objects that start with 's' and 't' and play I spy.
Thursday	s a t	sip and tent	stal	Robot talking- can you say these farmyard animals like a robot (e.g. c-ow, d-o-g, sh-ee-p, c-a-t, h-e-n)
Friday	s a t	sap act trim	tasp	Phonic story (please see video on SeeSaw).

Practice your Mathematics!

Monday	Choose a number 1-10. Practice writing it and find that many objects. Make sure you go back and check you have the right amount.
Tuesday	Comparing sizes- what can you find that is big/little, long/short, tall/short.
Wednesday	What 2D shapes do you know? Draw them and tell your grown up what you know about them.
